PIGEON FORGE, TN & ASHEVILLE, NC

Featuring The Biltmore Estate & Molly Brown Gilded Age Dinner

7 Days - 6 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1** A morning departure has you heading to your overnight stop for lodging (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own in the area.
- Day 2** After breakfast at the hotel, check out and continue traveling to Pigeon Forge, TN. Upon arrival you will check into your hotel for a three-night stay. You will have time to freshen up before departing for dinner at a popular restaurant, followed by a relaxing evening.
- Day 3** Enjoy breakfast, then depart for Bryson City to board the **Great Smoky Mountain Railroad** for a 4 1/2-hour roundtrip excursion that will take you 44 miles along the Tennessee and Nantahala Rivers to the Nantahala Gorge while enjoying scenic views, Bluegrass music, and Appalachian stories. This route has you traveling over the historic Fontana Trestle across the Fontana Lake and into the Nantahala Gorge. A layover stop will be made where you can disembark to stretch your legs, visit the shops and enjoy your **boxed lunch**. Return to the Bryson City Depot and depart for your return to Pigeon Forge to prepare for dinner. This evening's dinner will be at **Dolly Parton's Stampede Dinner Attraction** which is filled with friendly North and South competitions, thrilling horse riding stunts, spectacular special effects, and phenomenal musical productions.
- Day 4** Following breakfast, it's off to Asheville, NC and the **Biltmore Estate**, which was built in the 1800s by George W. Vanderbilt. The Biltmore is the largest privately-owned house in the United States. Arrive at the Biltmore Estate Group Sales Ticket Office to begin the **self-guided audio tour** of this 255-room French Renaissance-style chateau. There will be plenty of time to tour the gardens and visit the gift shops and conservatory. **Lunch** is included at the **Stable Café** on the Estate. After lunch, visit the Gift Shops, and the Antler Hill Village. Return to Pigeon Forge for dinner on your own and some shopping at **The Island**, a shopping and dining complex.
- Day 5** After breakfast, you will depart on a **Smoky Mountain Tour**. Your local guide will lead you on a tour of the Great Smoky Mountains. Enjoy the beauty and splendor of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. Afterwards, you will visit the **Ole Smoky Moonshine Distillery for a tour and tasting**. Continue to **Downtown Gatlinburg** where you will have free time to enjoy lunch on your own and visit the shops. This afternoon you will arrive at the **RMS Titanic Museum** for a self-guided tour. Each guest entering the museum will receive a boarding pass of an actual passenger or crew member; his or her fate will be revealed in the Titanic Memorial Room where the names of survivors and victims are posted. Experience what it was like on the ship. Walk the hallways, parlors, cabins, and Grand Staircase of the Titanic while surrounded by hundreds of artifacts directly from the ship and its passengers. Through interactive exhibits, learn what it was like on the RMS Titanic. Discover your passenger or crew's fate in the Titanic Memorial Room where 2,208 names line the historic wall. After your tour, you will have a **sit-down dinner with Margaret "Molly" Brown in Titanic's "Secret" private dining room** for a first class dinner in her honor. Learn how she became one of the most successful and famous women in the world, how and why she was on *Titanic* and the truth about her actions during and after the fatal sinking disaster. It promises to be a *Titanic* experience that you will never forget. Return to your hotel for a restful evening.
- Day 6** Enjoy breakfast, then check out and depart for your overnight stop for lodging (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 7** Breakfast, then check out and depart for home with lasting memories of your trip to Pigeon Forge.
